Runway Markings: Runways Classification: There are 3 types of runways, each with an associated level of markings: [Figure 1]Visual Runways: Visual runways are marked with the runway number and a dashed runway centerline [Figure 2]. Could also include threshold markings if intended for international operations; Aiming points may be included on runways 4,000' or longer used by jet aircraft
