After approximately 5 cycles of compressions and ventilations, or 2 minutes of CPR, the AED will instruct you to repeat steps 3 and 4- analyze the rhythm and push to shock if the rhythm requires a shock and the AED instructs you to do so. Continue CPR alternating with analysis of the rhythm until help arrives (i.e. EMS).

An AED can help the heart return to a normal heart rhythm. Start CPR if a choking victim becomes unresponsive. When doing CPR on an unresponsive choking victim always look for an object in the mouth before doing a rescue breath. For an unresponsive victim who is gasping, not breathing normally and with no pulse always start CPR.
