Use disinfecting wipes and sprays to kill flu viruses on contact. Ask them to keep a safe distance from others when possible and to cough/sneeze into the crook of their arm or into a tissue rather than into the air that others might breathe in. Vaccines - The most effective way to prevent the flu is to get a flu vaccine each year. Although vaccines are not 100% effective at preventing the flu, they can greatly reduce your chances of catching it.
