A Department of Transportation (DOT) physical examination must be conducted by a licensed "medical examiner" listed on the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) National Registry. The term includes, but is not limited to, doctors of medicine (MD), doctors of osteopathy (DO), physician assistants (PA), advanced practice nurses (APN), and doctors of chiropractic (DC).

You are required to complete and pass a DOT physical if you: Operate a motor vehicle for interstate commerce with a gross combination weight rating, gross vehicle weight rating, or gross combination weight of over 10,000 pounds. Operate a motor vehicle designed to carry more than 15 people.

To drive in intrastate or interstate commerce, you must have passed a medical examination, within the past 2 years, in accordance with Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations 49 CFR 391, Subpart E, as defined in the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's (FMCSA) Medical Examination Report. Commercial driver license (CDL) medical requirements

The DOT requires each commercial truck driver to pass a physical exam, stating that you are in good enough health to operate heavy machinery safely on the roads. Once the driver has passed his or her medical examination, they are issued a DOT medical certification card for them to pass along to their employer for documentation.
