Definition. Let M and N be differentiable manifolds and $f : M \rightarrow N$ be a differentiable map between them. The map f is a submersion at a point $p \in M$ if its differential $df_p : T_p M \rightarrow T_p N$ is a surjective linear map. In this case p is called a regular point of the map f , otherwise, p is a critical point. A point $y \in N$ is a regular value of f if all points p in the preimage $f^{-1}(y)$ are regular points.
