APA Research Paper Margins, Spacing and Typing Guide

Papers written in APA style should have 1 inch margins, according to the American Psychological Association website. Margin Guidelines The 6th edition of the APA Publication Manual requires each page of your paper to have a uniform 1 inch or 2.54 cm margins on the left, right, top and bottom of every page, including the title page, abstract and references pages.

Page Margins. The MLA Handbook dictates that you set your paper's margins to one inch, which means that there should be one inch of space between the text and the edge of the paper. Microsoft Word's default setting is one-inch margins, although some word processing programs are set at 1.25" or 1.5" as the default.

Use clean, good quality 8 1/2" x 11" white paper, one side only. 2. Margins. Leave margins of your essay 1" (2.5 cm) at the top, bottom, left and right sides of each and every page. 1" is about 10 typed spaces. Exception is made for page numbers which are placed 1/2" (1.25 cm) from the top upper-right hand corner, flushed to the right ...

Format for a Research Paper - A Research Guide for Students

Margins Except for the running head (see below), leave margins of one inch at the top and bottom and on both sides of the text. If you plan to submit a printout on paper larger than 8½ by 11 inches, do not print the text in an area greater than 6¼ by 9 inches.

Rule: Papers submitted for review or grading should have 1" margins all around. This should be the default for Word, but if your default setting is to have left and right margins of 1.25", change your default. Page length requirements are based on 1" margins.

General Format // Purdue Writing Lab

The text must be double-spaced, but quotations more than two lines long may be indented and single-spaced. Headings and footnotes may be single-spaced. Margins must be at least one inch on all four sides. Page numbers may be placed in the margins, but no text may appear there. (5) Typeface.

Rule 32. Form of Briefs, Appendices, and Other Papers ...

Most hiring managers prefer 1" margins, which are the default on Microsoft Word. However, you can move your margins within a range of ½"-1". For example, you might use 1" margins if you have less work experience. Or, you might prefer narrower page margins if you want to include more details on your resume.

One inch Margins One inch margins on the border of the document is the standard format. This means the right margins are one inch, the left margins are one inch, etc. This used to be a very important formatting convention when manuscripts were submitted as printed documents.

As a rule, go for slightly wider margins on the sides (creating a narrower text field). This will make it easier to read the document efficiently. From there, it's time to turn to the sides of the pleading, where the number lines are. You want to make sure that every line of the pleading matches with the numbers along the sides.

Legal Formatting: How to Properly Format Legal Documents

Identify your margin sizes using the chart at the end of this section. The chart provides the minimum requirements for your margin sizes, but we recommend a top and bottom margin of 1" if you're including headers and an outside margin of 0.375" (9.6 mm) to give your book a more professional appearance.
