Sidewalk design may be compromised by roadside design guidance that requires lateral offsets or clear zones forgiving to higher vehicle speeds. Use a lower design speed or widen the sidewalk to mitigate these impacts. Delineation of a strict clear zone or minimum offset is not a required feature in urban environments.

Adopt both a design vehicle and a control vehicle standard based on context-specific city street types. The design vehicle determines the design of elements such as turning radius and lane width.
